Item 8.01. Other Events.

As previously disclosed, the Incorporated Village of Head of the Harbor and certain other parties (collectively, the “Petitioners”) commenced a “Proceeding”) on April 26, 2022 against the Town of Smithtown and certain other parties, including Gyrodyne, LLC (“Gyrodyne”), seeking the Planning Board’s (the “Planning Board”) March 30, 2022 approval of Gyrodyne’s application for preliminary approval to divide its Flo Planning Board’s related findings statement.

As further disclosed, Gyrodyne and the Town of Smithtown filed motions to dismiss the Petition in June 2022 (the “Motions”).
